

MEMORIAL LAKE REGIONAL PARK

Campground Policy

Memorial Lake will be implementing their usual policies for securing the campground.

These include:

1. All campers on a site must be a minimum of 19 years of age unless accompanied by parents or guardians. Parents or guardians must remain on site for the entire period. This includes all seasonal camping permit holders.
2. Once camping unit per site - one (1) additional tent may be set up for minor children.
3. Quiet time is 11:00 p.m. Only registered campers will be allowed to remain in the campground after 11:00 p.m.
4. There are security personnel on duty from 9:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m. There is no entry into the park after 11:00 p.m. unless you are a registered camper or cabin owner. The gate is manned 24 hours.
5. Reservations are preferred. The park is usually full and people driving up without a reservation may not be able to camp. Call the campground office at (306) 427-2281.
6. There is a ZERO TOLERANCE Policy in force at all times. We will evict if needed. Our campers expect to enjoy themselves when in our care and measures will be taken to fulfill their expectations. The actions of a few will not be allowed to spoil the experiences of many.
