BYLAW NO. 2017-01

A BYLAW TO APPOINT MEMBERS AT LARGE TO THE MARTINS LAKE REGIONAL PARK AUTHORITY BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of the Martins Lake Regional Park Authority, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

TITLE

This Bylaw shall be referred to as the "MEMBERS AT LARGE BYLAW".

PURPOSE

1. To allow board members at large to be a part of the Martins Lake Regional Park Authority.

PART I: DEFINITIONS

In this Bylaw, the following words and terms shall have the indicated meaning, unless otherwise indicated elsewhere in the Bylaw:

Park Authority means the people who are, from time to time, appointed for the purpose of carrying out the management and administration of the Martins Lake Regional Park.

'Member(s)' or 'member(s) at large' means those person(s) who, by application, shall form a portion of the governing body of the park authority.

'Director(s)' or 'director(s) at large' means those person(s) who, by application, shall form a portion of the governing body of the park authority.

'Meeting' means a regular business meeting of the park authority.

'Leaseholder(s)' means a person or person(s) who hold a current cabin lot lease with the park authority.

'Application' means such form as is offered by the park authority and required submitted to the park authority by a required date in order to appoint interested persons that shall serve as members.

'Percent' means percent of the park authority as determined by the number of members in total as required by the Constitution of the Martins Lake Regional Park Authority.

'Term' is a period of four years that a member shall serve under any one appointment.

'Year' means the calendar year.

Applications shall be reviewed and subsequently members from those applications shall be appointed no later than the last regular business meeting of the park authority for the year.

- As are required to fill vacancies that may be filled by members at large
- For the prescribed term (four years), or
- To complete an abandoned appointment (balance of a previously appointed term)

Appointments shall commence at the first regular business meeting of the park authority in the new year immediately following the call for applicants.

Members at Large may not serve for more than two consecutive full terms and at the end of said terms shall reapply.

Upon coming into force of this bylaw the park authority may appoint one of the members at large for a term of two years and one members at large for a term of four years. Subsequent appointments shall be every two years thereafter for one of the members at large for a term of four years at each appointment.


Coming into Force


This bylaw revision shall come into force and take effect on final passing thereof.
