

Bylaw No. 2016-2

A BYLAW OF KEMOCA REGIONAL PARK AUTHORITY TO AMEND
BYLAW 86-1(87-2)

The Kemoca Regional Park Authority of Montmartre in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:


Bylaw #86-1 is amended as follows:

1. Section 2b) is repealed and the following substituted therefore:
"No person shall enter the park for the purpose of establishing a temporary residence by use of a trailer, mobile home or tent or for the purpose of overnight use of the park facilities without first purchasing a Saskatchewan Regional Park Season Pass or day pass and having paid the fees prescribed from time to time, by the Park Authority."
2. Section 3a) is repealed and the following substituted therefore:
"No person shall remain in the park after the hour of 11:00 p.m. without having obtained a day pass or seasonal park sticker."
3. Schedule B section 5) is repealed and the following substituted therefore:
"No area of the park may be used in such a way as to pollute, contaminate or cause other injury to swimming pool facilities."
4. Schedule B section 9) is repealed and the following substituted therefore:
"No person shall allow any domestic animal upon the playground or public building within the park."
5. Schedule B section 11) is repealed and the following substituted therefore:
"No person shall have or use within any park area any fireworks, firecrackers or other explosive or highly flammable matter except under the authority of a permit issued by an officer as per established park fireworks policy(est. 2010)"
6. Schedule B section 14) is repealed and the following substituted therefore:
"No person shall use any motorcycle or other motor driven vehicle on playgrounds, track, ball diamonds, golf course within a park area."
7. Section 25) per Bylaw #87-2 is repealed and the following substituted therefore:
"No child age 6 or younger may enter the swimming pool unless accompanied by an adult. Accompanied mean they must never be left alone in the water and that the adult must always be within arms reach. Adult means a responsible person 13yrs of age or older."
8. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing thereof.


