

BYLAW No. 2016 - 3

**A BYLAW TO PERMIT OPERATING GOLF CART WITHIN THE LIMITS OF KEMOCA REGIONAL PARK FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRAVELLING TO AND FROM A GOLF COURSE.**

Subject to and in accordance with, s. 113.1 of *The Traffic Safety Act* and *The Registration Exemption and Reciprocity Regulations* (2014):

The Kemoca Regional Park Authority of Montmartre in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. It shall be lawful to operate a golf cart during the hours between one-half hour prior to sunrise and one-half hour after sunset on Park roadways within the Regional Park boundaries strictly for the sole purpose of travelling by the most direct route between the golf course and the golfer's campsite.
2. No one shall operate a Golf Cart in Kemoca Regional Park unless they hold a valid Class 7 or learner's driver's license.
3. Owner of the Golf Cart must carry a minimum of \$200,000 in third party liability insurance, to insure themselves and every other person who, with owner's consent, operates that golf cart, against liability imposed by law arising out the ownership, use or operation of that golf cart and provides proof of insurance at request of Park Manager or Park Authority
4. Golf Carts must be operated in accordance with the rules of the road in *The Traffic Safety Act* and any other Municipal Bylaw related to traffic.
5. All personal and public liability will be the responsibility of the owner/operator of the said Golf Cart.
6. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon approval thereof by Saskatchewan Government Insurance
