

BIG RIVER REGIONAL PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

OFFICE HOURS: 9:00am to 9:00 pm or as posted.

DAILY OR SEASONAL PARK PASSES MUST BE PURCHASED TO ENTER/USE ANY OF THE PARK FACILITIES & PASSES MUST BE DISPLAYED IN CLEAR VIEW IN VEHICLE WINDOW. One park pass per vehicle.

CHECK IN & OUT TIME: Check in @ noon, checkout @ 11:00 am.

QUIET TIME: 11:00 pm – 8:00 am

CAMPING: Two camping units permitted in some sites; **BOTH PAY CAMPING FEE.** Any other accommodations (i.e., tents, sleeping in vehicles etc, will be charged \$11/unit/night)

CAMPSITES: Registered guests only may occupy a site. You can not sublet your site. If you vacate your site (including seasonals) the site reverts back to the park with no refund

CHILDREN must be supervised at all times to ensure their safety. No glass containers in the playground area. Use of playground area is at your own risk.

PETS: Permission maybe given for pets, but **must be kept on a leash at all times**, not to be left unattended. Please clean up after your pet, owner must control pet noise.

ROADWAYS: must be kept clear, do not block campsites, additional parking permitted in designated areas. Speed limit is 15 km with in the park boundaries.

ATV'S – can be driven out of the park in designated sites (36-49). If you are not in a designated site, ATV's must be hauled in and out of the park. No ATV's are to be driven in or out of Cowan Lake Campground

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES allowed in campsites only

WASHING OF VEHICLES OR CAMPERS IN THE CAMPGROUNDS OR CAMPSITE IS PROHIBITED

FIREWOOD: provided at no charge located near Park office. Firewood is not to leave the park facilities. If you take more than you use, return the excess to the wood shack upon departure.

GARBAGE: Bagged waste only in bins near park office. **NO FISH WASTE OR LIVE COALS.** Do not leave garbage in sites

WE RECYCLE: please help us to save our environment. Place recyclable cans, glass, and plastic beverage containers in the bin by the garbage.

CIGARETTE BUTTS: Please place Cigarette butts in a container, **NOT ON THE GROUND**

CANNABIS: The use of cannabis is **strictly prohibited** on all Regional Park Property

MATS: If you are here for an extended stay and leave the campground for more than 48 hours, mats must be lifted off the ground. No mats allowed beneath camping units

TREES: Please do not climb on, cut or damage any trees in the park

TARPS: allowed in rainy or windy weather, must not surround campsite

FIRES: Permitted in metal fire boxes or fire ring only

FIREWORKS ARE PROHIBITED IN THE PARK

POWER USAGE: over use of power is prohibited. If you are paying for a 30-amp service, you can not use more than 30 amp. Electrical cords can not be taped, wired or otherwise modified. **NO GENERATORS ALLOWED**

WATER PRESSURE: Our water pressure runs at approximately 38 LBS pressure, we have a gauge to test each site if you are concerned, a water pressure regulator is recommended.

FISH FILLETING BUILDING: at Cowan Lake Campground. Open 9:00 am – 9:00 pm, you must clean up after use.

SEWER SITES MUST HAVE SEWER CAP COVERS (must be sealed, not just hose in sewer)

DUMPING OF GRAY AND BLACK WATER IN CAMPGROUND IS PROHIBITED. Please use dumping station located at the community campground.

LAUNDRY FACILITIES: in park office \$2.00 per load

COIN OPERATED SHOWERS: \$2:00 for 4 minutes, use multiple coins for a longer shower

FOR SEASONAL CAMPERS - WHEN YOU LEAVE YOUR CAMPSITE:

1. Fires must be extinguished
2. AC/Furnace is turned off
3. Garbage disposed of in bins
4. Site left tidy
5. Mats lifted off the ground

Big River Regional Park Authority reserves the right to evict anyone causing a disturbance OR not following the rules and regulations (without refunds).

Big River Regional Park Authority has the right to refuse anyone to camp in park if they feel it is necessary. Entering the park is at your own risk. The Big River Regional Park Authority will not be responsible for any lost, stolen or damage of personal property of any kind. Please keep your valuables secured and report any crime to RCMP.

Big River Regional Park Authority has made these rules and regulations for all visitors to be followed for everyone's safety and enjoyment. We as the Big River Regional Park Authority have given authority in our absence to our Maintenance Person &/or Park Administrator to enforce these Rules & Regulations
